## **50 yard 22 LR Rimfire Match**

Location: Rose-Iris Range

Time: Saturday morning from 07:15 to 09:00. Registration begins at 07:15 and ends promptly at 7:45, first shots at 07:55, timed shoot ends at 08:20, scores and awards announced at 8:45, complete by 08:50 when Rose-Iris opens to the public.

Participants: Match is limited to 20 shooters, one relay only. The first 20 registrants will participate. No advance registration. Arrive early to secure a spot. Match will proceed on tight schedule as it is important we clear the area before the general public arrives at 09:00.

Dates: Sat April 24, Sat May 29, Sat June 12, Sat July 10, Sat Aug 7, and Sat Sept 18

Course of fire: Unlimited sighters, 25 shots for score.

Time: Timed event, with all shots including sighters complete in 25 minutes, no alibis or time extensions, so we can complete before the range opens to the public. All shooters shoot simultaneously on their own target.

Target: USBR 50 yard bench rest target. This target has 25 individual targets for score, and 3 targets which can be used for sighters. Shooters may also add their own sighter targets to the target holder if they wish.

Format: Range starts hot, and shooters bring out their firearm to a bench. Each shooter goes to a bench on one side of the range shack, if we have enough shooters, both sides will be used. Each shooter will then check in and receive a target. When all shooters have checked in, range is declared cold and all shooters take targets down range simultaneously at 07:50. Once all targets are in place, range goes hot, and when all shooters are ready, RO gives the command to begin fire and the 25 minute clock starts. During that time shooters may fire as many sighters as they choose, but may only fire 25 shots for record, one shot on each of the 25 scoring bulls on each target. When the end of time is called, all shooting ceases, and rifles are made safe. When all rifles are safe, the RO gives the command for range cold, and all shooters retrieve their targets. Shooters then pass targets to the right (or left) for scoring by adjacent shooter. When all targets are scored they are turned in to RO for determining placing. RO declares range hot and shooters put away their rifles.

Fee: \$10 per shooter. \$5 goes to the range, \$2 goes to payout for winner/s, \$1 for targets, and \$2 for coffee and donuts for the next match.

Firearms: 22 cal rimfire only. Iron sights or scopes allowed. Front of the firearm may be supported by sand bag, bi-pod, or sling only. Specialized bench rest supports (commercial or homemade) are not allowed. No rear support is allowed. Shooter is required to support rear of the firearm, no sand bags, squeeze bags, or other supports.
