

2010 Rattlesnake Trap League Rules

1. League shooting will be held on the following Sundays:

January 3	February 7
January 10	February 14
January 17	February 21
January 24	February 28
January 31	March 7
2. The shotgun range opens at 9 am. League shooting will be between the hours of 9 am and noon each Sunday. Hours may be extended based on the number of participants.
3. Scoring will be based on 1 round of trap (25 shells) from the 16-yard line.
4. The round scored for the league must be declared prior to shooting. League rounds shall be scored by the League Chair or persons deemed appropriate by the League Chair.
5. Rattlesnake Mountain rules are applied to the league scoring. Questions regarding scoring rules shall be refereed to the League Chair.
6. Scores will be called out prior to moving between posts. Discrepancies shall be corrected prior to shooting at the next post. Scores shall be checked at the end of the round. Scores posted in the clubhouse are official.
7. League trophies and monies will be based on the eight highest scores accumulated over the ten weeks.
8. If a participant misses a week they will be allowed to shoot the following league day. If the participant fails to make up the score, no score will be posted for the week missed. No make up dates will be allowed for March 7th, the last day of league.
9. The entry fee is \$10. One hundred percent of monies will be returned back to the participants in the form of cash and prizes. Shooters will pay for their own targets and shells. Shells will be available at the gun club.
10. Trophy List
 - First through fifth place overall (5 highest scores)
 - Special category classes (i.e., sub-junior, junior, lady, veteran, husband/wife, father/son, etc.) may receive awards based on the number of participants for each category
11. Monies will be paid based on a Lewis Class system. The number of classes will be based on the number of participants. Each class will have an equal percentage of the pot. Each class will pay the top three places at 50% for first, 30% for second and 20% for third. Questions regarding the Lewis Class systems can be directed to the League Chair.

12. In the event of a tie (for trophies or monies), a shoot-off will be conducted at the awards banquet. Shoot-off format will be successive rounds of trap until a winner has been declared.
13. Trophies will be awarded at the Shooter Appreciation Day. The format for the Shooter Appreciation Day has not been determined but will be communicated to the participants in advance. The projected date is March 14th.
14. Every Sunday during the league shoot there will be a special event called "5 from 40." The cost will be \$5 to enter. The participant will shot at five birds from a pre-determined location approximately 40 yards from the trap machine. The participant(s) with the highest score will split the pot with the league.

The "5 from 40" will be held at approximately noon each day or when league shooting has slowed to a point that allows the event to be held. Further details are to be provided.
