## MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

**Adult Membership:** Any one person over the age of 18 years of age, who will be 18 years of age for the entire membership year, and who does not meet senior status. **Junior members may be included on Adult Memberships. See the Junior Memberships definitions below.**

**Senior Membership:** Any one person 65 years of age, during the entire membership year, and who has been a TCSA member for the last five consecutive years. **Junior members may be included on Senior Memberships. See the Junior Memberships definitions below.**

The TCSA Board of Directors limits spending and uses volunteer labor at every opportunity in order to keep membership dues affordable for everyone. They request that seniors pay Adult Memberships unless the difference in cost severely deters their ability to enjoy the sport of shooting. All members meeting senior status in the above paragraph will be processed as a senior if so requested, without question or comment.

**Spousal/Couple Membership:** Two Adults (spouses) meeting the qualifications for adult membership or senior membership. Membership cards bearing the same number will be issued to both members on the couple membership. **Junior members may be included on the Spousal/Couple Membership. See the Junior Membership definitions below.**

**Junior Members:** Children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, etc may be included as members on Adult, Senior, or Spousal/Couple Memberships. These young people, usually under the age of 18, will receive membership cards with the same number as their sponsoring adult at no additional charge to the sponsor. Junior members are required to be accompanied to the range and supervised at the range by their sponsor, parent or guardian. Young adults over the age of 18 who are students or who are carried as dependents on the family income taxes may also be included as junior members. Non-member, non-shooting adults accompanying junior members to the range are not required to pay range fees but are required to supervise juniors.

It is the wish of the Board of Directors that youth members take pride in their TCSA Membership and take seriously the adult responsibility of safe handling and shooting of firearms.

**Pro-Rated Membership Dues (The TCSA Membership Year is Apr 1 to Mar 31.)** Persons purchasing membership in TCSA pay a full-year membership fee when joining, no matter which month. The next year's membership fee will then be pro-rated depending on the month of the year in which the new member(s) joined.

**New members joining TCSA will be billed on April 1 following their joining according to the scale as follows:**

**March 1 through Sept. 30 will be billed a full-year's membership the following April 1.**

**October 1 through February 28 (29) will be 60% of a full year membership the following year.**

**Members who have not renewed by May 1 will be asked to renew memberships before being permitted to shoot at any of the ranges.**

**Military Personnel:** Active Duty Military Personnel, Reservists, National Guard Members, Law Enforcement Officers in Uniform, and Retired Military Personnel with a Retired ID Card are invited to utilize TCSA range facilities as our guests requiring no payment of range fees. There may be, however, fees incidental to specific ranges that will be charged.
