Advance registration is required, and must be postmarked by 6 February, 2017. All entries must be paid at time of registration, and both Team members must pay to reserve slot. Match fees will be refunded if requested prior to 10 February 2017. Late entries will only be accepted to a fill out match capacity of 64 shooters/32 Teams.

Canadian payment must be in USD, drawn on a bank whose checks can be processed by the U.S. Automated Clearing House (ACH) system. NO CANADIAN POSTAL MONEY ORDERS PLEASE!

The CBC is a multi-day Precision Rifle event held annually at the Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility. Rattlesnake is located between Benton City & Richland, in SE Washington State. Based on tactical and hunting scenarios, it requires shooters to engage multiple static & moving steel targets from 200 – 1000 yards under realistic field conditions and time constraints. The weather is typically reasonable the 3rd week of February, and offers competitors the opportunity to tune up their skills while the rest of the Pacific Northwest is covered in fog, drizzle, ice & snow.

For 2017 CBC is part of the Rifleman's Team Challenge, and will include the RTC 2-person Team format for the entire match. RTC rules & guidelines will be followed as closely as possible; visit www.riflemansteamchallenge.com, and click on the 2017 Guidelines tab on their Home Page.
