

**Tri-Cities Shooting Association, Inc.
Presents the 2016 Hunter Sight-In - 200 Yards**

DATE: Saturday, October 1, 2016

Shooting begin at 9 am and lasts until 3pm.

LOCATION: Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility located 10 miles NW of Richland, WA. Access to the range is through the gate on SR 225 (Horn Road) approximately 3 mi south of SR 240 and approximately 8.5 mi north of I-82 in Benton City. Facilities at the range are primitive. Lavatories are available (portapotties) but there is no water. Please prepare accordingly.

OPEN TO: Any individual with a safe rifle. Rifles are limited to no more than .35 caliber so the marker disks will stay in the holes.

RULES: This is informal. The distance is 200 yards. The targets are 4' by 6' paper (supplied by the TCSA.) The center is a black 12" bull. Each single shot will be scored with a visible spotting disc. Groups may be fired with permission of the Range Safety Officer. Ammunition may be commercial manufactured or hand loaded safe ammunition and will be provided by the shooter. Tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited.

Please do not drive ANYWHERE off the graveled roads and/or graveled parking areas. Please do NOT drive or park on any of the graded shooting line positions.

Do NOT remove any firearms from your vehicle before signing in and checking with a Range Safety Officer at the firing point you have been assigned.

FEES: Free. This is a public service event sponsored by the TCSA .

OTHER DETAILS:

- Ear and eye protection is required.
- Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) are required (available at range.)
