

**The TRI-CITIES SHOOTING ASSOCIATION**  
Presents The  
**RATTLESNAKE FULLBORE RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP**  
(N.R.A. Registered)  
DATE: Aug 6 & 7, 2016

LOCATION: Rattlesnake Mtn. Shooting Facility, 10 Mi. NW of Richland, WA. Access to the range is thru the Main Gate, located at MP 8.5, North of I-82 (Benton City), or 3 Mi South of Hwy 240 on Hwy 225.

RULES : Current [NRA International Fullbore Prone Rifle Rules](#) shall apply. Eye and hearing protection is REQUIRED.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to individual members of the NRA, or of the national rifle association of the country of residence, except that Juniors may be members of an NRA/DCRA affiliated club in lieu of individual membership.

ADVANCE ENTRIES PLEASE: All entries to be paid in advance. (Checks will not be cashed until after the match.) Advance notification allows us to run an efficient match that begins on time. Please mail, eMail, or 'phone in your entry information BEFORE you arrive.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry on the attached Entry Form which includes: NRA Member ID#, Name, Address, E-mail Addr, FB Class, Award Category, & Rifle Category. Entries need be accompanied by NRA points, money order or check drawn on a US bank and made payable to 'TCSA HiPower'. Mail to Bob Gudgel, 5510 W Umatilla Ave., Kennewick, WA 99336. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request. There will be no refunds for those canceling after the match begins.

TEAM ENTRY: Team captains make entry prior to the start of team match. Teams will consist of 4 persons.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday, 1 Aug, 2016. Late Entries received after this time may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only.

ENTRY LIMIT: 60 individual entries.

ENTRY FEE: NRA fees of \$5.50 are included. (Military sponsored competitors must make advance arrangements to pay.) Juniors half price.

- INDIVIDUAL: Both days ( Sat., Sun.), \$50; One day \$30.
- TEAM: \$10 per team member, payable with team entry prior to team match.

CHALLENGE FEE: A \$1 fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.

TARGETS & SERVICE: NRA LR & LR-F target. Competitors will pull targets.

EMPTY CHAMBER Indicator is required to be used at all times prior to match preparation time. After firing is complete, scorekeeper must inspect the chamber before reinserting the ECI.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded for **String Firing** rule 8.2.1.. Score cards and squadding will be issued after 7:00 AM each day. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding by 8 AM will only be squadded to fill vacancies. NRA/DCRA classification cards must be shown to be squadded.

SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA International Fullbore Classification will be used. Rule 19.6, "Assigned Classification" may be used. Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master class.

RIFLES: Target Rifle rule 3.3.5.(Division "A"), F-Class (Division "F"). Other Division "A" rifles: Service Rifle rule 3.5 . Division "F" rifles: Rule Book Sec. 22: Open Rifle rule 3.4a and T/R Rifle rule 3.4b. Target Rifle rules require the use of 7.62mm (.308 Win.) Max. bullet Wt. < 156g or 5.56mm (.223 Rem) Max. bullet Wt. < 92g ammunition.

CATEGORIES: Service (Incl. Reserve & Nat'l Guard), Civilian Service Rifle, Target and F-Class (Open & FTR) rifle. Competitors must shoot their discipline specific rifles in all individual matches to be eligible for Category awards.

AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to the Match Winner of each Division and to the high individuals in each Division/Category/Class award group for each match in accordance with a schedule posted in the Stat. Office. Awards must be picked up before the end of the tournament or be donated to the TCSA Junior Program. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Additional place awards will be given based on one award for each 7 competitors.

SPECIAL AWARDS: In Match #3, a High Junior, High Woman, High Senior, High Grand Senior and **High F-T/R** award will be given if 5 or more compete in the category.

CHALLENGE PERIOD ends 30 Min. after the posting of match results.

#### **MATCH SCHEDULE**

SATURDAY: Beginning at 8 AM , **Match 1: 2 Convertable** Sighters (Rule 9.2) and 15 shots for record, 900 yards, 22 Min.; **Match 2: 2 Convertable** Sighters and 15 shots for record, 1000 yards. .

MATCH #3: THE RATTLESNAKE FULLBORE CHAMPIONSHIP - An aggregate of individual scores fired in matches #1, and #2

SUNDAY: Beginning at 8 AM, **TEAM Match 1:** 2 Convertable Sighters and 15 shots for record, 1000 yards. In two 47 Min.periods. Followed by **TEAM Match 2:** 2 Convertable Sighters and 15 shots for record, 1000 yards. In two 47 Min.periods. Two additional convertible sighters will be allowed for interruption due to pit change.

#### **OTHER DETAILS**

Practice Firing: The match fees do not include RMSF range fees for individuals practicing on the day before the match. The range will be open from 9AM to 3PM on the 5<sup>th</sup> (Fri.). Those individuals wishing to practice will pay \$10, to the Range Officer in charge.

Food: Bring your own WATER and food. No lunch break.

Camping: This is a primitive range. NO WATER or electrical hook ups. Camping in self contained campers & motor homes O.K. You will be required to sign an annual 'Camping Agreement'. Call Bob at (509) 783-5111 for entry instructions. Also, nearby (2 mile), is a County park on the Yakima River. It has full hook-up and no hook-up sites at moderate cost. No reservation system is in place at this time. Accommodations may be found in nearby Richland (10 mi.) and restaurants and groceries in Benton City (5 mi.).

Airport: TRI-CITIES Airport is located in Pasco (PSC), 10 Mi. from Richland, and is served by Delta, Horizon, & United Express air lines.
