LOCATION: Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility, 10 miles Northwest of Richland, WA. Access to the range is thru the Main Gate, located at MP 8.5, North of I-82 (Benton City), or 3 Miles South of Hwy 240, on Hwy 225. Map available at: <http://www.tcsa.info/directions>.

RULES: Current NRA High Power and Black Powder Target Rifle rules shall apply.

This will be a dual match with simultaneous firing for:

- All Black Powder Target Rifles as defined in the NRA Black Powder Target Rifle Rule Book
- All High Power and F-Class Rifles as defined in the NRA High Power Rifle Rule Book

Eye and hearing protection is required both in the pits and on the firing line.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to individual members of the NRA or DCRA, except that Juniors may be members of a NRA/DCRA affiliated club in lieu of individual membership. High Power and F-Class Long Range Distinguished Long Range Leg match requirements are found at <http://www.wsrpa.net/wsrpa/highpower/hp-info>. Competitors must be a member of the Washington State Rifle and Pistol Association to be eligible for leg points. WSR&PA memberships (\$30) will be available at the range.

ADVANCE INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES REQUIRED: Mail entry & fee on attached Entry Form. All entries to be paid in advance, and postmarked by Saturday, 6 October 2018. Alternatively, payment can be made via PayPal Friends & Family to TCSAHighPower@gmail.com.

TEAM ENTRY: Team Captains will register Friday prior to the Team match. Teams will consist of 4 persons.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries close Tuesday, 9 October (must be postmarked by 6 October). Late entries received after this time will only be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays

ENTRY LIMIT: Sixty (60) individual shooters total, on a 1st registered/1st squadded basis.

ENTRY FEE(S): NRA fees of \$9 per competitor and \$5 per Team are included.

- **INDIVIDUAL:** Two days \$60; one day \$40. Junior competitors are half price
- **TEAM:** \$10 per Team member, payable with Team entry prior to Team match.
- **LEG:** No charge, but current WSR&PA membership is required.
- **WSR&PA:** \$30, if not already a member, or member of other state/provence association.

TARGETS & TARGET SERVICE:

- NRA LR or LRFC targets will be used.
- Competitors will pull targets. Competitors failing to pull targets, or to provide an adequate substitute, may be disqualified.

SCORING: Competitors will score. Competitors failing to perform scoring duties may be disqualified.

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR: ECI is required to be used at all times prior to match preparation time and after firing is complete. After firing is complete scorekeeper must inspect chamber before reinserting ECI.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. A competitor who fails to check in prior to the required time will only be squadded to fill vacancies in existing relays.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Rule 19.6 "Assigned Classification" may be used. Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master class. NRA/DCRA classification must be shown.

EQUIPMENT and AMMUNITION: This will be a dual match with simultaneous firing for:

- All Black Powder Target Rifles including
 - 3.1 Black Powder Target Rifles
 - 3.2 Black Powder Military Rifles
- All High Power Rifles including
 - 3.1 Service Rifle, (M1, M14, M16, & M110)
 - 3.2 Any Rifle
 - 3.3 NRA Match Rifle
 - 3.3.1 U.S. Palma Rifle
 - 3.3.2 NRA Any Sight Match Rifle/Tactical Rifle
 - 22.3.4 F Class Rifle (F-Open & F-T/R)

Competitors must shoot their discipline specific rifles in all individual matches to be eligible for Category awards. Full rules are available at: <http://www.nrahq.org/compete/nra-rule-books.asp>.

Any safe rifle may participate. However, to have the scores reported to the NRA, the equipment must comply with one of the categories from the applicable current NRA rule book. Shooters are responsible to self-identify the particular type of rifle for those compliant with the NRA rule book in order to have their scores reported to the NRA. At Match Director's discretion, other safe, non-compliant rifles may be allowed to participate, including those with muzzle brakes and suppressors; scores will not be reported to the NRA.

Any safe ammunition may be used; the use of tracer, incendiary, or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited. **Fired rounds that fail to reach the target at supersonic velocity and/or fail to impact the target berm will cause the competitor to be removed from the firing line (velocity requirements not applicable to BPTR).**

CONCURRENT CHAMPIONSHIP MATCHES: High Power/F-Class matches will be fired concurrent with Black Powder Target Rifle (BPTR) matches; time limits are the same, only the round count will differ; squadding and firing points will be segregated to the extent possible.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

High Power - Friday - The Team PALMA Course of Fire for High Power Rifles

- Two sighters and 15 shots for record from 800 yards.
- Two sighters and 15 shots for record from 900 yards.
- Two sighters and 15 shots for record from 1000 yards.
- COF will be shot in two 47 minute periods, with 2 additional sighters allowed for interruption due to pit change.

High Power - Friday (Optional) – ANY Rifle / ANY Sight Match at 1000 Yards

- Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes

High Power - Saturday - Match # 1 - The Individual PALMA Course of Fire

- Unlimited sighters and 15 shots for record from 800 yards. Time limit of 22 minutes.
- Two sighters and 15 shots for record from 900 yards. Time limit of 22 minutes.
- Two sighters and 15 shots for record from 1000 yards. Time limit of 22 minutes.

High Power - Saturday - Match # 2 – ANY Rifle / IRON Sight Match at 1000 Yards

- Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes

High Power - Sunday - Match # 3 - The Individual PALMA Course of Fire

- Unlimited sighters and 15 shots for record from 800 yards. Time limit of 22 minutes.
- Two sighters and 15 shots for record from 900 yards. Time limit of 22 minutes.
- Two sighters and 15 shots for record from 1000 yards. Time limit of 22 minutes.

High Power – Match # 4 – The Rattlesnake Long Range Regional Championship

- The aggregate of the individual scores fired in matches #1, #2 and #3.

Black Powder Target Rifle – Saturday - Match # 1 - The Individual CREEDMOOR Course of Fire

- Unlimited sighters and 10 record shots from 800 yards in 22 minutes.
- Unlimited sighters and 10 record shots from 900 yards in 22 minutes.
- Unlimited sighters and 10 shots for record from 1000 yards in 22 minutes.

Black Powder Target Rifle – Saturday Match # 2 – ANY Rifle / Any Sight Match at 1000 Yards

- Unlimited sighters and 10 shots for record in 30 minutes

Black Powder Target Rifle – Sunday - Match # 3 - The Individual CREEDMOOR Course of Fire

- Unlimited sighters and 10 record shots from 800 yards in 22 minutes.
- Unlimited sighters and 10 record shots from 900 yards in 22 minutes.
- Unlimited sighters and 10 shots for record from 1000 yards in 22 minutes.

Scores from Saturday's match #1 will be used to determine the WSR&PA Long Range Leg Match awards. **The Rattlesnake NRA Regional Championships will be determined by the aggregate of individual scores fired in matches #1, #2 & #3.**

REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS (provided by the NRA):

Match Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion

2nd Place: NRA Regional Silver Medallion

3rd Place: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion

1st High Master and 1st Master: NRA Regional Division Awards

AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to the Match Winners, and to the high individuals in each Division/Category/Class award group for each match. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors, or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group. Additional place awards will be given based on 1 award for each 7 additional competitors. Awards must be picked up before the end of the tournament, or be donated to the TCSA High Power Junior Program.

SPECIAL AWARDS: In Match # 4 (Aggregate) a High Junior, High Woman, High Senior and High Grand Senior award will be given if 5 or more compete in a category.

OTHER DETAILS:

Practice Firing: Match fees DO NOT include High Power range fees for individuals practicing on the days prior to the match. Individuals practice is \$10 per day, payable to Range Officer in charge. Contact Match Director for practice schedule.

Sustenance & Weather: Bring your own WATER and food. No organized lunch break will be taken. Plan for inclement weather (i.e. heat or cold, sun, rain, wind). **There is no shade or shelter on the High Power range, so please plan accordingly.**

Accommodations: This is a primitive range. Portable toilets will be available. NO WATER or electrical hook ups at the range. Nearby (2 miles), is the Horn Rapids County Park on the Yakima River. It has full RV hook-up and no hook-up sites at moderate cost. No reservation system is in place at this time. Other accommodations may be found nearby in Richland (10 mi.), restaurants and groceries in Benton City (5 mi.)

Airport: The Tri-Cities airport is located in Pasco (PSC). It is 20 miles from the range, and is served by Delta, Horizon and United Express airlines.
