DATE: June 27 and 28, 2015

LOCATION: Rattlesnake Mtn. Shooting Facility, 10 Mi. NW of Richland, WA. Access to the range is thru the Main Gate, located at MP 8.5, North of I-82 (Benton City), or 3 Mi South of Hwy 240 on Hwy 225.

RULES : Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules shall apply. Eye and hearing protection is REQUIRED.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to individual members of the NRA, or DCRA, except that Juniors may be members of an NRA/DCRA affiliated club in lieu of individual membership. All competitors must be a current member of the WSR&PA or other state or province association affiliated with the NRA or DCRA. Leg match requirements may be found [here](#) or [\(F\) here](#). WSR&PA memberships will be available (\$30) at the match.

ADVANCE ENTRIES PLEASE: All entries to be paid in advance. (Checks will not be cashed until after the match.) Advance notification allows us to run an efficient match that begins on time. Please mail, eMail, or 'phone in your entry information BEFORE you arrive.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry on the attached Entry Form which includes: NRA Member ID#, Name, Address, E-mail Addr, LR Class, Award Category, & Rifle Category. Entries MUST be accompanied by NRA points, money order or check drawn on a US bank and made payable to 'TCSA HiPower'. Mail to John Hauptmann, 121 Timmerman Dr., Richland, WA 99352. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request. There will be no refunds for those canceling after the match begins.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday, 22 June 2015. Late Entries received after this time may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only.

ENTRY LIMIT: 60 individual entries.

ENTRY FEE: NRA fees of \$5.50 and WSR&PA fees of \$3 per competitor are included. (Military sponsored competitors must make advance arrangements to pay.) Juniors half price.

- INDIVIDUAL: Two days, \$60; One day \$40.
- LEG: No charge for those qualified. Current WSR&PA membership is required.

CHALLENGE FEE: A \$1 fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.

TARGETS & SERVICE: NRA LR and LR-F target. Competitors will pull targets.

EMPTY CHAMBER Indicator is required to be used at all times prior to match preparation time. After firing is complete, scorekeeper must inspect the chamber before reinserting the ECI.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Score cards and squadding will be issued after 7:30 AM each day. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding by 8 AM will only be squadded to fill vacancies. NRA/DCRA classification cards must be shown to be squadded.

SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Rule 19.6, "Assigned Classification" may be used. Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master class.

RIFLES: NRA Any Rifle as limited by Match Program (i.e. sights) rule 3.2 (Division "A"), F-Class (Division "F"). Other Division "A" rifles: Service Rifle rule 3.1, NRA Match Rifle rule 3.3, and U.S. Palma Rifle rule 3.3.1. Division "F" rifles: Open Rifle rule 3.4a and T/R Rifle rule 3.4b.

PALMA® Rifle and FTR rules require the use of 7.62mm (.308 Win.) or 5.56mm (.223 Rem) ammunition.

CATEGORIES: Service (Incl. Reserve & Nat'l Guard), Civilian Service Rifle, PALMA® Rifle, Match Rifle, and F-Class (Open & FTR) rifle. Competitors must shoot their discipline specific rifles in all individual matches to be eligible for Category awards.

AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to the Match Winner of each Division and to the high individuals in each Division/Category/Class award group for each match in accordance with a schedule posted in the Stat. Office. Awards must be picked up before the end of the tournament or be donated to the TCSA Junior Program. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Additional place awards will be given based on one award for each 7 competitors.

SPECIAL AWARDS: In Match #4, a High Junior, High Woman, High Senior, High Grand Senior and **High F-T/R** award will be given if 5 or more compete in the category.

CHALLENGE PERIOD ends 30 Min. after the posting of match results.

MATCH SCHEDULE

SATURDAY: Beginning at 8:30AM,

Match #1 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record, ANY Rifle, ANY Sights at 1000yds. Time limit 30 minutes.

Match #2 & Match #3 - ANY Rifle, IRON Sight Match at 1000 Yds. Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record. Time limit 30 minutes. Scores from Match 2 & Match 3 will be used to determine WSR&PA Long Range Leg Match awards.

SUNDAY: Beginning at 8:30AM,

Match #4 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record, ANY Rifle, ANY Sights at 1000yds. Time limit 30 minutes.

Match #5 - ANY Rifle, IRON Sight Match at 1000 Yds. Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record. Time limit 30 minutes.

MATCH #6: THE WASHINGTON STATE LONG RANGE CHAMPIONSHIP - An aggregate of individual scores fired in matches #1, thru #5.

OTHER DETAILS

Practice Firing: Beginning at 9AM Friday, from the 1000yd line. Pay \$10 to the Range Officer in charge.

Food: Bring your own WATER and food. No lunch break.

Camping: This is a primitive range. NO WATER or electrical hook ups. Camping in self contained campers & motor homes O.K. You will be required to sign an annual 'Camping Agreement'. Call John at (509) 308-9230 for entry instructions. Also, nearby (2 mile), is a County park on the Yakima River. It has full hook-up and no hook-up sites at moderate cost. No reservation system is in place at this time. Accommodations may be found in nearby Richland (10 mi.) and restaurants and groceries in Benton City (5 mi.).

Airport: TRI-CITIES Airport is located in Pasco (PSC), 10 Mi. from Richland, and is served by Delta, Horizon, & United Express air lines. Many of the car rental agencies are represented at the airport.
