LOCATION: Highpower Rifle Range Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility, located on SR 225 (Horn Road) approximately 3 miles south of the intersection with SR240 and approximately 3 miles north of Benton City, WA. [How to get to the range.](#)

OPEN TO Any individual.

RULES: Modified NRA International Fullbore Prone & High Power Rules apply. Any safe .22 caliber rimfire (non-magnum) rifle/load and any sight are welcome. Bipods are allowed.

ENTRY FEE: \$10 for adults, Juniors are free. No cash prizes will be awarded in 2015.

REGISTRATION: Entries will be accepted until 30 minutes before shooting is scheduled up to a range capacity of 60 competitors. Please be prompt. It is not fair to the other competitors to delay shooting because you are tardy.

AMMUNITION: Any safe .22LR ammunition may be used. In order to maintain range safety, the use of tracer, incendiary, or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited.

OPEN BOLT / EMPTY CHAMBER indicator is required to be used prior to match preparation time and after your firing is complete. Indicators are available at the range.

TARGETS: 100 yd. NRA A-25 single center, 200 yd. NRA A-21 will be used.

SCORING: Competitors will score and be required to pull targets when in the pit.

COURSE of FIRE:

Mandatory Orientation and Safety meeting for all competitors prior to start of shooting.

3 minute preparation time

5 sighters and 20 shots for record, prone at 100 Yds. Time limit: 25 min.

3 minute preparation time.

5 sighters and 20 shots for record, prone at 200 Yds. Time limit: 25 min.

OTHER DETAILS:

Food - Bring your own WATER and food. No lunch break.

Competitors will be required to pull targets or bring another person to pull targets for the shooter.

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): An Empty Chamber Indicator is required to be in your rifle at all times except during the preparation period and the firing of your relay.

Please have an Empty Chamber Indicator in your rifle when you arrive at the range to check in.

If you do not have an Empty Chamber indicator, please arrive at the range with your rifle unloaded and the action open. Let the Match Director know you do not have an Empty Chamber Indicator, and one will be provided.

HANDLING OF FIREARMS:

Handling firearms behind the firing line is not permitted. The handling of firearms is defined as anything a competitor does to operate the mechanism, shoulder, aim, put a sling on, load, practice loading, insert a clip or magazine, or otherwise perform any action that would prepare the competitor to fire the firearm.

Adjusting or blackening sights, adjusting slings without placing them on the arm or making minor adjustments to the firearm in the ready area or behind the firing line is not regarded as handling the firearm, and is permitted as long as an ECI remains inserted.

Competitors may load clips or removable magazines in the ready area (so long as they are not inserted in the firearm).

After competitors are instructed to carry their rifles and equipment to the firing line, they are permitted to handle their rifles on the firing line as long as the muzzle remains pointed up or downrange and an ECI remains inserted. After arrival at the firing line and prior to the start of the preparation period, competitors may put a sling on and assume position with the rifle. Competitors may not remove the ECI, close the action or dry fire until the Range Officer announces the start of the preparation period.
