

**Tri-Cities Shooting Association, Inc. Presents:
NRA APPROVED HIGH POWER RIFLE MATCH
For Match and Service Rifles, Tournament Id: 2019160495**

DATE: Sat. & Sun. May 11-12, 2019, Registration 8 AM

LOCATION: Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility, located on SR 225 (Horn Road) approximately 3 mi southwest of the intersection of SR 240 and SR 225 (toward Horn Rapids Park) and approximately 3 mi north of Benton City.

RULES: NRA High Power Rules apply. Any safe rifle/load and any sight up to .35 caliber may fire, but will not compete for prizes or classification.

ENTRY FEES: \$20 each day - \$35 for both Saturday and Sunday. Junior fees are ½ price

MATCH SCHEDULE: Both days: 0815 Orientation and Safety meeting for all competitors
0830 the 80 shot Regional Match Course

Match 1 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, standing at 200 yards. Time limit: 22 min.

Match 2 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, sitting or kneeling, rapid fire at 200 yards. Time limit: 60 sec per 10 shot string.

Match 3 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, prone, rapid fire at 300 yards. Time limit: 70 sec per 10 shot string.

Match 4 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, prone at 600 yards. Time limit: 22 min.

Match 6 – Aggregate of matches 1 through 4 on May 11th.

Match 7 – Aggregate of matches 1 through 4 on May 12th.

Match 8 – Aggregate all matches of May 11th and May 12th.

REGISTRATION: Entries accepted until 0830 up to a range capacity of 60 competitors. Stats office will open at 0800 on match days for post entries and to conduct squadding.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Five or more competitors will make a class. Any class with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher class. If fewer than 5 High Masters enter, they will compete for Match Winner only.

ARM: Must meet NRA High Power rule 3.1 or 3.3 to qualify for prizes or NRA scoring. All other rifle/ammunition combinations deemed safe for the distance may fire up to .35 caliber. The same rifle must be used for all matches.

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition may be used. Tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited.

TARGETS: 200 yard SR, 300 yard SR-3, 600 yard MR-1.

SCORING: Competitors will score and will be required to pull targets.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented based on the number of competitors in each class.

NOTES: Facilities at the range are primitive. Lavatories are available (portable) but there is no water. Please prepare accordingly.
